

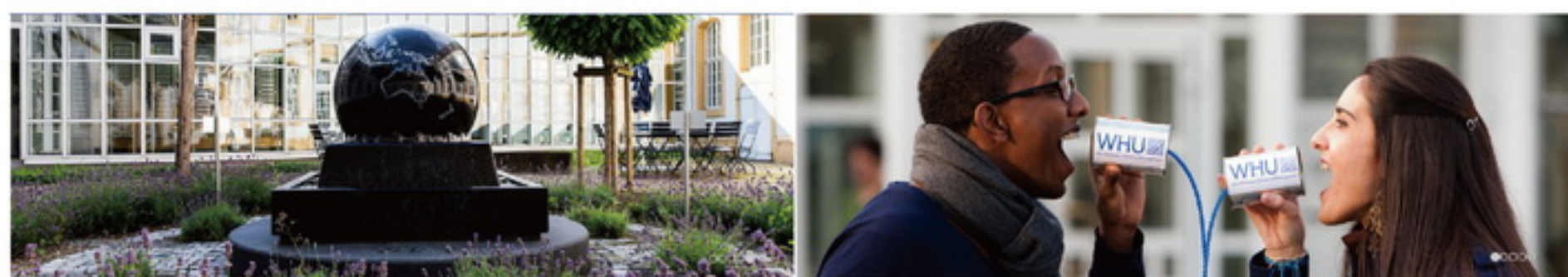


WHU Otto Beisheim School of Management
